LOCAL SPECIFICATIONS FOR SEWING 100% COTTON PROCEDURE MASKS

MASK COMPONENT	SEWING DIRECTIONS
FABRIC	USE CLEAN 100% COTTON . SOFTER MATERIAL SUCH AS USED FOR BABY BLANKETS IS DESIRABLE
	COLOR OR PATTERNS DO NOT MATTER
LAYERS	MASK SHOULD BE CONSTRUCTED WITH A DOUBLE LAYER FOR PROTECTIVE PURPOSES
PLEATS ON FRONT OF MASK	DESIRABLE AS THEY WILL FIT THE WEARER BETTER - 3 PLEATS
TIES OR ELASTIC LOOPS	EITHER IS ACCEPTABLE. IF ELASTIC IS USED, IT SHOULD BE LATEX FREE
NOSE PIECE TO ASSIST WITH FIT AROUND THE NOSE AND CHEEKS	THIS IS ALSO DESIRABLE FOR BETTER PROTECTION. LENGTH OF WIRE IS 4"-5"
	A STIFF BENDABLE WIRE SUCH AS A LONGER PLASTIC TIE USED FOR BREAD/FOOD PRODUCTS CAN BE USED. OTHER OPTIONS CAN BE CONSIDERED AS WELL AS LONG THEY ARE WASHABLE AND WILL NOT PUNCTURE MATERIAL OR INJURE WEARERS FACE
TEMPLATE	THERE ARE MANY TEMPLATES ON THE INTERNET THAT CAN BE USED. SELECT ONE THAT PROVIDES ADEQUATE FACE COVERAGE AS IN IMAGE BELOW
