

Parishioners near death have expressed the comfort they experience knowing the Parish Community is praying for them. Please join us in this sacred prayer.

Dear Good People,

I hope this letter finds you well as we continue on our Advent journey. Just a reminder about all the good things that are happening. This weekend we bless all those expectant mothers as they prepare with Our Lady to give birth. We also have the Holy Day of obligation (Opportunity) to celebrate the Immaculate Conception of the Blessed Virgin Mary on Monday, Dec. 8th. A reminder that mass times are 7AM and 6:30PM at St. Mary. After the 6:30 Mass we are having a pizza and dessert party. Thank you to the Stewardship Committee for putting this on.

Secondly, please note the extra time for the sacrament of reconciliation. If one of these times does not work for you, I am available for confession by appointment. Just email or text me.

Finally, as I write this, we are breaking record cold numbers for December. Last week we broke the snowfall record for November. I will do everything in my power to have mass. The issue on Sunday was that we could not get things cleared at Holy Cross with the wind. I also was not able to get out of my driveway as I had about a 4 foot drift. KCCI also got overwhelmed with calls. Please as usual use your best judgment when coming to mass, but most of the time I will try to have mass unless again we have unprecedented snow amounts with blowing and drifting snow.
