It is customary at our Parish that after the final song, the assembly kneels and silently prays the "Our Father, Hail Mary, and Glory Be" for the next person of our Parish who passes away. Parishioners near death have expressed the comfort they experience knowing the Parish Community is praying for them. Please join us in this sacred prayer.

Dear Good People,

This weekend we celebrate Gaudete Sunday. Its name is taken from the entrance antiphon of the Mass, which is: Rejoice in the Lord always; again I say, rejoice. Indeed, the Lord is near. This is a quotation from Philippians 4:4-5, and in Latin, the first word of the antiphon is gaudete (Latin, "rejoice"; it's also pronounced with three syllables: gau-de-te). Advent is the season of preparing for the arrival of the Lord Jesus (both his first coming and his second coming), and by the third Sunday of Advent, we are most of the way through the season. Thus, it is appropriate to rejoice as we see the goal of the season approaching: "The Lord is near."

Secondly, I wanted just to say thank you to the Stewardship Committee for putting on our Pizza and dessert party after mass for the Immaculate Conception. It was an outstanding turn out and party. Thank you to all who participated. I also wanted to thank everyone who provided wonderful hospitality for our funeral lunch for our dear friend JoAnn.
