




It also reminds us that we are called to follow him, and to trust in his guidance and protection. As we reflect on this image of the Good Shepherd, we are invited to consider the quality of our own relationship with Jesus. Do we recognize his voice and follow him? Do we trust in his care and protection, even in the face of difficulty or uncertainty? Are we willing to let him guide us on the path he has set for us? Some good things for all of us to reflect on.
