

## Readings and Questions for Faith Sharing

#### Second Sunday of Lent, February 24/25

Theme: Seeing Jesus

Reading I: Genesis 22:1-2, 9, 10-13, 15-18 • Because you trusted me, I will bless you greatly.

Reading II: Romans 8:31-34 • Who can be against us?

Gospel: Mark 9:2-10 • He was transfigured before their eyes!

For Children: Name or draw a picture of a time you knew that Jesus was with you.

For Youth: The disciples had a very intense experience of Jesus on the mountain. Have you ever had a "mountain" top" experience? What was it like for you?

For Adults: In what ways does Jesus speak today, ways in which you can truly "listen to him?"
