# **Committee Reports**

- Finance Council Update (Summary to be presented by Doug Jones)
  - $\circ$   $\;$  Finance council suggested PC make an appropriate decision for the roof replacement  $\;$
- Building & Grounds (John Roberts)
  - Roof damage estimates at SM & at HC
    - We had to get a new quote for the church roof
    - Current quote went to the Diocese who got another quote which was double our current low quote
    - Some concern from with Iowa Legend quote, but follow ups seem to be covered (see email John sent to PC)
    - We are waiting for a final confirmation back from Iowa Legends
    - Some concern over the age of the shingle (50 year shingle and these were installed in 2006)

- This was concerning the parish hall side
- Contractors are saying that it is best to complete both the church and the parish hall side.
- Motion to accept current bid from Legends with the possible addition of \$5000 if a review shows a mistake: John Fisher motion, Stacey Rooney Seconds. Further discussion. Motion passes.
  - Discussion surrounding the desire for clarification on the current quote.
- ACTION: John will work with Scott to bring a recommendation to the council for action.
  - Updated quote (12/3/20) to re-roof church and social hall from Legends is \$48,643.52.
- Long Range Planning
  - This should be a living document shared with PC for awareness/discussion
- Prioritization of needs for B&G
  - 1 year
  - 5 years
  - 10 years and beyond
- Water Softener
  - Samples were taken waiting to hear back
  - Action Item: John Roberts Follow up with Culligan.
- Could be the right time to put something in the bulletin to encourage donations to the building fund.
  - Action: Revisit this topic at the next PC meeting.
