Committee Reports

- Finance Council Update (Summary to be presented by Doug Jones)
 - o 2020-21 Budget
 - Guessing game at this point, Original proposal will go to the diocese
 - Budget discussion & approval
 - Grant from the US Government has been rolled into the budget
 - The plan submitted is about 75% of last year
 - No changes needed at this time
 - o Recruiting & succession plan

Building & Grounds (John Roberts)

- Roof damage estimates at SM & at HC
 - Last roof replacement 1999 Wood Shingle Co. DSM \$27,832
 - Was this a complete refinish?
 - Looking for a quote for a total replacement vs a repair.
 - Scott is waiting for a price back from Advantage Exteriors
 - We need to find 1-2 more quotes
 - o ACTION: John will continue to work with Scott to bring a recommendation to the council for action.
