## Old business review:

- 1. Omlet scramble successful: approximately 50 people attended
- 2. No new report from finance.
- 3. Building and grounds: Currently waiting on man lift for steeple repair and gutter cleaning. Furnace repair; council voted yes to approve furnace repair for \$1600.00 Stained glass windows in need of repair/replacement. Storm windows need updated.
