

## **Readings and Ouestions for Faith Sharing**

Fifth Sunday of Easter, April 27/28

Theme: I am the vine; you are the branches.

Reading I: Acts 9:26-31 • The church was at peace. Reading II: 1 John 3:18-24 • We are called to believe and to love one another.

Gospel: John 15:1-8 • I am the vine.

For Children: How do you keep yourself connected to Jesus in your daily life?

For Youth: Jesus is the vine - we are the branches, connected to Him as our life-source. When do you feel most connected to Jesus in your everyday life? How can you go there more often?

For Adults: How does your own connection to Christ, the vine, affect your daily life? What image from this reading helps you see the importance of this connection to Christ?
